

# Adobe Creative Cloud Network Endpoints

This document contains lists of network endpoints for websites and specific services that are offered as part of the Adobe® Creative Cloud™. As explained in *Controlling Access to Creative Cloud Services*, a firewall can be configured to block some of these endpoints so as to prevent access to Creative Cloud services by users in a customer organization. Blocking the services and websites listed in this document will *not* block Creative Cloud Packager access to desktop applications.

In order to be effective, firewall rules must block access to the regional endpoints as well as the globally defined endpoints.
